We only accept work that has not been previously published.

Formatting Guidelines

Papers **must** be prepared using the **Ini format** (<u>author instructions</u>, Englisch information can be accessed at the bottom of the page). Short papers have a length of 4 to 6 pages including illustrations, references and appendices, long papers a length of 8 to 10 pages including illustrations, references and appendices.

Submissions must be anonymized.

Permissions to reprint illustrations included in your manuscript must be obtained if required by the original publisher. Submissions that do not follow the lni format and/or are not anonymized will not be accepted for reviewing.

Usage of Generative Models

The German Research Foundation states: "Only the natural persons responsible can appear as authors in research publications.
